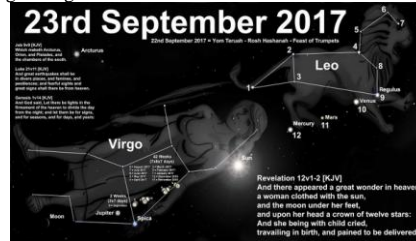

On Prayer 52 Watch and Pray (Part Four)

In Luke 12:35-37 we see a special blessing on those who are found watching when the Lord comes:

“Let your waist be girded and your lamps burning; and you yourselves be like men who wait for their master, when he will return... ..blessed are those servants whom the master, when he comes, will find watching. Assuredly, I say to you that he will gird himself and have them sit down to eat, and will come and serve them.”

That is beyond comprehension. The King of kings wants to serve us! Doesn't that give you the determination to set aside a specific time to spend with him daily?

Some morning you may wake up and find the newspaper saying, “World Peace At Last! Salt 12 has been signed. There will be no more threat of nuclear war.” That will be the most important day in your life to pray. I Thes 5:3-9 says, “When they say, ‘Peace and safety!’ then sudden destruction comes upon them, as labor pains upon a pregnant woman. And they shall not escape. But you brethren... ..**watch and be sober**. For God did not appoint us to wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus.”

We must watch the world situation. There will be no peace until the Prince of Peace comes. I Pet 4:7 says that the “end of all things is at hand; therefore be serious and watchful in your prayers.” If the end of all things is at hand, then we have to be serious about watching and praying.

Many people will fall into temptation because they forget to watch and pray. We overcome temptation by being watchful. I Pet 5:8-9 says, “Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour. Resist him, steadfast in faith, knowing that the same sufferings are experienced by your brotherhood in the world.”

Satan tries to possess our future and depress us into wrong paths I have been under satanic attack that almost resulted in my leaving my church. I seriously considered it for two years. Why? Because the forces of darkness tried to discourage and destroy me so they could possess my future.

Now I have victory over that. At first I didn't understand the satanic attack; but, after getting beat up round after round, I realized what they were trying to do.

I have talked with pastors and Christian leaders all over the country who have experienced similar attacks. There is a pattern in this: the devil steals and crushes our joy; then he can possess our vision. He tries to depress us so he can capture our future. Then he tries to get us to resign or leave our church.

Why am I being this transparent? It is because we all face the same afflictions and sufferings. I know if the shepherds get discouraged and beaten down, the forces of darkness can work the same demonic attack on you. They will try to crush your joy and steal the life blood out of your vision. Watch and pray! My trial was no different than yours. It wasn't any worse or any easier. It had the same kind of satanic pattern to it.

Pastors and church leaders, watch and pray for your flock. “Be watchful in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry” (II Tim 4:5).

Watch out for the wolf – the person who tries to draw the flock away from the real gospel:

“Take heed to yourselves... ..for I know this, that after my departure, savage wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock. Also from among yourselves, men will rise up, speaking perverse things to draw away the disciples after themselves.

Therefore watch, and remember that for three years I did not cease to warn everyone night and day with tears” (Act 20:28-31).

The Christian leader is responsible to watch out for the souls of the flock as one who must give an account. (see Heb 13:17.)

In the same way, we must watch and pray for our pastors and those in leadership. Col 4:2-3 says, “Continue earnestly in prayer, being vigilant [watchful] in it with thanksgiving; meanwhile while praying also for us [pastors, elders, deacons, home group leaders, Sunday school teachers] that God would open to us [them] a door for the word, to speak the mystery of Christ.”

Pray that doors would open to further the gospel. We need to watch out for and build each up in intercession.

Yeshua exhorts us to “be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die” (Rev 3:2). This is a last days verse for us who live in the period when Yeshua said, “And because lawlessness is increased, most people's love will grow cold. But the one who endures to the end, he shall be saved” (Mat 24:12-13). We must take this verse seriously and be watchful, strengthening in our Lord Jesus.

Jesus also said, “Behold, I am coming as a thief. Blessed is he who **watches**, and keeps his garments, lest he walk naked and see his shame” (Rev 16:15). The Lord pronounced a special blessing on the person who doesn't allow someone to steal his robe of righteousness and keeps himself pure and holy – morally, financially, and ethically.

Blessed is the person who, in these last days, is full of integrity and love with no guile or deceit. Watch so that no person is used by the enemy to steal your robe of righteousness and you are never guilty of removing the robe of righteousness from another person's life. **Watch and pray!**

Satan's Playbook

We see the addictions, not the wounds; the rebellion, not the rejections; the drunkenness, and not the depression; the illusion, but not the deception. Houdini used to fool the crowd by deception. Satan also fools the crowd through deception. We need to be able to pick out the wolves in sheep's clothing as God has assigned us (Mat 7:15, 10:16). A wolf may look and act like a sheep, but it cannot hide its wolf footprints as it walks.

We must be careful not to fall into Satan's plan to divide. If Satan can divide the family or friendship, then he can make us vulnerable to him. When we become bitter or resentful, we should pray the prayer that Paul prayed for the Ephesians (Eph 1:17-18). In Satan's plan to steal, kill, and destroy, he will do anything necessary to destroy our lives and our assignments. How many of us, we that follow the Lord Jesus Christ, are actually fighting the good fight? We pray for God's will, that we are making the right decisions, and that we are walking in what God wants us to do. Yes, trouble comes and trials, and at times, even suffering, but this does not interfere with God's plan for our life. We must be careful not to allow these bumps in the road to divert us from our final destination.

There are three ways that Satan will try to bluff us. Bluff number one is that he makes people think he is present everywhere (Omnipresent – I see us falling for it when I hear people say, 'The devil is coming against me, Satan is attacking me, the devil made me do it.' Satan himself does not know I exist. I am not important enough to him. He cannot be in two places at once; only God can, but we seem to want to ascribe this power to him. He must rely on his minions to be somewhere else.) The second bluff is that he makes people think he is all-knowing (Omniscient – only God is omniscient). Bluff number three is that he makes people think he is all-powerful (Omnipotent – he is not). The enemy wants you to think he is stronger, smarter, and greater than he actually is. This deception appears to be confirmed when we look around and see the influence that evil has over society and throughout the world. He has played the game longer than us and has a playbook full of strategies and tricks that have been effective for millennia. In all this, there are three primary methods by which trouble manifests: self-invited trouble, uninvited trouble, and natural trouble.

We are always rebuking fiery darts that are coming against us. After more than 6000 years of experience in battle strategies, the lust of the flesh, lust of the eyes, and the pride of life are the three main missiles from which other darts originate. This is why Paul wrote in II Cor 2:11, 'lest Satan should take advantage of us; for we are **not** ignorant of his devices.' One of Satan's greatest devices is fiery darts that are sent into the mind in the form of wrong thoughts. This creates confusion, division, and temptation (Eph 6:16).

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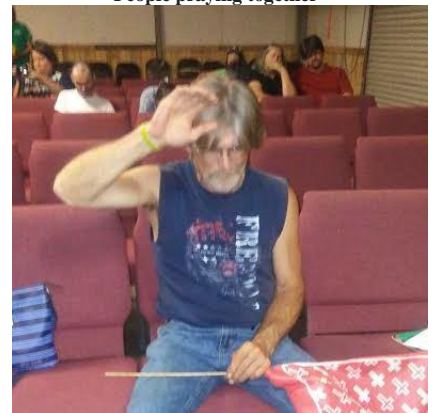

We must get rid of pride and a critical spirit. Only you can bring real unity – Jesus. Our adversary is out there trying to steal your time. It could've been you leading lost people to Christ. Jesus said, 'My sheep know my voice,' and he said, 'I know them,' and 'they follow me.' If he does not know you, you are not in the fold."

about to give birth. Then another sign appeared in heaven: an enormous red dragon with seven heads and ten horns and seven crowns on its heads. Its tail swept a third of the stars out of the sky and flung them to the earth. The dragon stood in front of the woman who was about to give birth, so that it might devour her child the moment he was born. She gave birth to a son, a male child, who "will rule all the nations with an iron scepter." And her child was snatched up to God and to his throne. - Revelation 12:1-5

The astronomical alignment that so many are now pointing to comes from a literal reading of Revelation 12:1-5, which describes a sign in the sky involving a woman who is crowned with twelve stars, clothed with the sun, having the moon under her feet, and giving birth to a male child. The text itself does not describe the sign as a parable or illustration, which validates the view that this passage is in fact describing a real astronomical event visible to the inhabitants of the earth - complete with real sun, moon, and stars. Each of the elements described in the sign have significant prophetic and allegorical meaning as will be shown, but the passage itself describes first and foremost a real sign and so any accurate interpretation must begin with that premise. Lacking any evidence that the Apostle John was not describing a sign visible in the sky as the text plainly says, the burden of proof is entirely upon those who would argue that this passage is only pure allegory.

There has been much confusion over both the Hebrew and Greek words for heaven. In the Greek, the word in Revelation 12:1 is ouranos (oo-ron-oss) with a definite article, which can be translated as "in heaven" or "in the sky." The distinction is a big deal, because many who deny a literal one thousand-year kingdom of Christ and the earthly fulfillment of Old Testament covenant promises, will opt for "heaven" being the translation every

time. The same goes for Revelation 21:1. John sees what is often translated "a new heaven" and "a new earth." However, it may be better to translate this as "a new sky," rather than confusing modern readers by using a word in modern English most often associated with God's dwelling place.

It is also important to note that these first five verses in Revelation 12 purposefully distinguish between two different signs. The first sign, which the text calls "a great sign", involves only a woman in labor, and so includes Revelation 12:1-2 and Revelation 12:5. The second sign, called "another sign", is described in Revelation 12:3-4. The signs are connected in the narrative, but their distinction tells us that they are not the same and this is the likely reason that only the first sign has been apparently identified in the Fall of 2017. A number of different explanations for the second sign have been offered, such as an as of yet unseen stellar or planetary body, but that is not the topic of this study. Our focus is entirely on the "great sign".

Virgo, Latin for "virgin" or "maiden", is the second largest constellation in the sky and one of the twelve constellations of the Zodiac and Jewish Mazzaroth (the constellations that the sun appears to move through during the course of the year). In most depictions, it features twelve principal stars as can be seen in the picture above (pg one). Spica, along with three other stars, forms a womb-of-sorts at the center of the constellation. Virgo is universally depicted as a woman, even in the ancient Grecian, Roman, and Assyrian-Babylonian cultures, and for this reason, it is argued that this is the "woman" John saw in the sky. It is the only constellation in the Zodiac and Mazzaroth that represents a woman, and out of the 88 constellations in the entire celestial sphere, it is one of only three constellations that represent women (the other two being Andromeda and Cassiopeia).

Our solar system's star is mentioned by name in Revelation 12:1 as part of the sign. It is said to "clothe" the woman. From the perspective of a viewer on earth, the sun is always much smaller than Virgo and therefore it cannot be the disc of the sun itself that clothes her in any arrangement, but on September 23rd it will rest upon her shoulder and the sign will be entirely "clothed" in sunlight during the day on September 22nd and 23rd, **hiding Virgo from view.**

The lunar body is also mentioned by name in Revelation 12:1, described as residing under the woman's feet. On September 23rd, from the perspective of a viewer in the Middle East, Virgo will appear prone and the moon will appear directly under the feet of the constellation.

It is not uncommon for Virgo to be "clothed" in the sun and to have the moon under or near her feet - in fact it happens every year for a number of days in the Fall. It is the crown of twelve stars that John saw that really begins to set this sign apart. This is far, far more rare. The Hebrew and Greek words for "star" do not distinguish between stars as we know them today and planets. From the perspective of an earth-based observer, stars and planets look the same except that planets appear to move through the field of fixed stars. For this reason, planets were sometimes described in the ancient languages as "wandering", but they were still called stars. Situated directly above the head of the constellation Virgo is the constellation Leo ("The Lion"), composed of nine principal stars. On September 22nd and 23rd the visible planets Mercury, Mars, and Venus will join Leo's nine stars to form a "crown" of twelve stars on the head of Virgo.

On November 20th, 2016, the planet Jupiter entered the womb of the constellation Virgo where it will remain for exactly 42 weeks, the precise length of a human gestation cycle. The 42 week gestation is interesting in light of the 42 generations from Abraham to Christ (Matthew 1:17) A crown of twelve stars above Virgo's head is rare, but this is

rarer still. In order for Jupiter to remain in the womb for such a lengthy and precise amount of time, it undergoes an extremely rare retrograde motion in the constellation. The planet actually appears to make a giant circle within the womb during this time before exiting on September 9th, 2017. The sign in Revelation 12 completes in verse 5 after the child is born, and likewise two weeks after Jupiter exits the womb, it moves down the celestial birthing canal and the complete sign is formed in the sky. It could be said that the woman is in labor for two weeks as the baby moves out of the womb and through the canal.

NO ONE KNOWS THE DAY OR THE HOUR? All the Spring Feasts were fulfilled at Christ's first coming, and on the exact day of the feast. All the Fall Feasts picture the second advent, and the Feast of Trumpets is the first of the fall feasts. The Feast of Trumpets is followed by The Day of Atonement and then the Feast of Tabernacles.

The Feast of Trumpets is also called "Yom Teruah" or the day of blowing of trumpets. It is Israel's call to repentance and a day of reckoning, God entering into judgment with His people. John the Baptist and Jesus both had a call to repentance. The Feast of Trumpets precedes the Day of Atonement where there is redemption and forgiveness of sin. It's an annual reminder to us as Christians to reevaluate our lives and repent of known sin.

100 trumpet blasts are made on The Feast of Trumpets. The "last trump" is the longest and loudest. This is believed to be related to the last trump of I Cor 15:50-52. Related passages in Mat 24:31 and I Thes 4:16-17 also mention trumpet calls.

I Corinthians 15:51, "Behold, I tell you a mystery: We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed— 52 in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed."

So what was Paul talking about when he mentioned this event happening at the 'last trumpet'? The last trump was a phrase known at the time and spoke of the last great trumpet that occurred on the feast of Trumpets. On that day 100 trumpet blasts were heard. The last one was called 'the last trump'. Arnold Fructenbaum writes: 'Paul is writing from his own Pharisaic, rabbinic background. The last trump is a technical term for the final, long, and most significant trumpet blast of the Feast of Trumpets... ..Paul was saying that the Feast of Trumpets was going to be fulfilled by the rapture of the Church.' So here we have even further proof that the rapture and resurrection is tied directly with this next feast.

I will end with this thought. Revelation 12:5 She bore a male Child who was to rule all nations with a 'rod of iron.' And her Child was caught up to God and His throne.

The day of Pentecost was when the Church was **conceived**, could September 23rd, 2017 be the **birth** of the Church?

Revelation 2:25, "But that which ye have already hold fast till I come. 26 And he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations: 27 And he shall rule them with a 'rod of iron.' as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father.

Rom 5:10, ‘When we were enemies, we were reconciled to God through the death of his Son... we shall be saved by his life.’ Rom 5:18, ‘As through one man’s offense judgment came to all men... so through one man’s righteous act, the gift came to all men.’ Relationship with God must be restored. Through the death of his son it was made possible for God’s enemies to be restored to him. “The Bible says, ‘Know them that labor among you.’ It is time be reconciled back to God, no matter what denomination you are from. This does not give you a religious right to keep sinning. The Lord said in John 15:15 that we have been changed from servants to friends.”

you receive God’s transfusion, he recognizes the blood and passes over you and yours in the blood.

It is a gift. How many times do we make ourselves feel guilty and refuse to forgive ourselves, carrying that shame and guilt?

“The blood of Christ connects us to God. Col 1:21-23 was to remind the church in Colosse of their former alienation from God (Col. 1:21) and of the great price which Christ paid to reconcile us to God (Col. 1:22). At one point we could not access the holy places. We were given personal access – all-access pass to the holy places because of Jesus. Imagine you have access to someone when there is darkness and when there is light. You can talk to him. He can be a part of you.

“The blood of Christ allows us to conquer the enemies in our lives. How many of us have these nagging sins? I have to deal with the lack of confidence, gossip, fear, lying, feeling worthless. But when we accept the blood, the blood is a gift, so he gave us the key. If we use the blood we can overcome everything.

“He sees me as beautiful, yet broken. God sees us as beautiful. In our society, we disregard broken things, but through his brokenness, the most important gift was given: his powerful blood, that power of the blood that changes you. The most important thing is we must lay down our pride.”

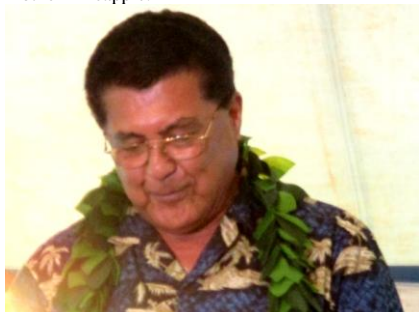

Greg Brockman, headmaster of North Georgia Revival School of Ministry spoke briefly. "I never cast out a demon in the name of a nondenominational, Baptist, or Presbyterian; only in the name of Jesus. God chose us to be here at this time, for such a time as this, to make an impact. He's here. He's 145-years-old, with the Methuselah anointing." He introduced the evangelist of Aloha Ministries, Les Vinluan, Brother Pineapple.

"We are hearing about 'fake news,' and the devil is adding his lies," Brother Pineapple told the people. "Lies are even creeping into our churches. Tell god in the next few minutes, 'Speak to me.'"

"We need to examine ourselves. Why? It is because we have left the basics. You say you pray, but you don't. You say you read the word, but you don't. Pray for people who carry Unforgiveness. It is like a cancer. Get rid of it. There are people in the world looking for the real thing. God could've chosen anybody, but he chose you and me. The world says the salt has lost its savor, the light has gone out. Jesus is the light. We went to buy 100 watt bulbs, but the sign said, 'sale' and we bought 75 watt bulbs, the 60 watt. We are losing our light. We are to place the salt in the wound and it is supposed to sting. The wound is the world system. We put in the salt and there's no sting. It has lost its saltiness. The one who needs to change is Brother Pineapple. II Tim 4:2-5, in season and out of season. The time will come when men will not endure sound doctrine.

"There are nine characteristics we need to have. First, we need to have steadfast eyes. Act 4:12, there is no other name under heaven by which we must be saved. Phil 2:9-10, his name above all names, every knee and every tongue. We need our eyes on Jesus without losing focus.

The second characteristic is we need to have thick skin. II Tim 3:17, thoroughly equipped for every good work. We must be able to accept criticism.

Thirdly, we need to have tough toes. We need to learn to take correction. Who the Lord loves, he chastens. II Tim 3:16, for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness. Prov 3:11, my son, do not despise the chastening of the Lord. Mat 6:33, seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness. There is scripture you need to memorize. Somebody tonight is dropping off into a godless eternity. Do you care? Lord, let the tears flow from my eyes.

Fourth, we need fast feet. We need to be able to get away from negative people, quitters, and evil compromise. Ps 1:1, walk not in the counsel of the ungodly. In Gen 39:12, rather than be caught up in sin, Joseph left his garment and ran.

Fifth, we need busy hands. Use time wisely. The devil is stealing your time. God redeem my time for the days are evil. Are you getting caught up in the falling away? Why? You don't pray anymore. You get off to one side of the church away from everybody. You are not forgiving. You get caught up in the falling away. It is time to get to the altar and pray, 'God free me.'

The sixth characteristic is we need to have limber knees. Did you pray for the man of God at this tent tonight? You need to be in prayer for all in leadership. Mark 1:35, a solitary place. You have not because you ask not.

Seventh, we need to have a learning mind, reading the word of God. He is not interested in quantity, but quality. I believe God will use remnants – people willing to pay the price. He will give them power from on high. God looks at you and sees perfection because he sees his son, who is perfect.

Eighth, we need a Christ-like spirit. Phil 2:5, let this mind be in you that was also in Christ Jesus. Your behavior and language is to be Christ-like. Some of you let the devil come into the church with you. Greater is he that is in you than he that is in the world.

Lastly, we need an aching heart for the lost and dying world. He gave me a burden for lost souls, and only he can lift it. You can try to lift it, but it won't work. You can get up here and preach without the anointing and power and it won't matter. We need to cry out to God in a loud voice, go to him in agony for the people. We plant, but only one brings the increase – God."

An altar call was given. Pastor Dustin Bonds called people up for prayer and Pastor James Walker

Turned up the volume and spoke to the community through the microphone. "I have seen all of this from my tower. We serve the devil notice right now. You are evicted from this community right now!"

On this particular evening, Pastor Bryant Ware was the main speaker. He delivered a sermon that touched many in the neighborhood.

Pastor started out with the story of an elderly couple who had been together for 50 years, and when his wife was asked to make him a cup of coffee and she refused he couldn't believe it. Her response was "it is in the Bible: HeBrews" His message was brought from Hebrews 11, entitled *Faith Flowing Under the Tent*. "You are in the right place at the right time period. We may all look different here, but our main ingredient links us all together, and that is faith. You can't praise the Lord or please the Lord without faith. God has already released the gift of faith. What he has done through us, was done according to the Faith from within us. The faith does the work. Persecution: we endure similar persecutions. Right now some claim to know Christ, but they will stand against you. They will try to hinder your ministry. It takes faith, from the Greek Pistis. It means a conviction of the truth of anything."

There were three key points that he outlined.

1. Present realization
2. Proven revelation
3. Promised reward

Pentecost

Pentecost occurred 50 days after Jesus rose from the dead. Jesus had already gone back to Heaven so the disciples and new believers of Jesus were waiting to receive the Holy Spirit because that's what Jesus told them would happen. Plus, since Jesus wasn't with them any more the Holy Spirit would help bring them closer to God.

Just before Jesus was taken up to heaven he told them that they would receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on them and they'd be his witnesses in the whole world (Acts 1:8). Even more, he told them much earlier that the counselor (or Holy Spirit) would be sent by the Father, that He would teach them all things and remind them of everything he said to them (John 14:26).

So, the Holy Spirit is super helpful to us. He becomes a part of us when we become a Christian and understand that Jesus died and rose for us. When we're ready to try to live a life pleasing to God the Holy Spirit becomes part of us so we have a part of God with us all the time.

The day of Pentecost was a bit different though. People had already become Christians but the Holy Spirit wasn't a part of them yet. This would be the first time everyone who was a Christian would receive the Holy Spirit.

Pentecost was a day to celebrate the end of the grain harvest. It was like Thanksgiving is for us in Canada when the farmers have collected their crops and all the hard work is done.

The people would offer two loaves of bread they had made from their crops and two lambs were waved before the Lord as a thank offering. This was their special way of thanking God for the weather and for helping them get a crop for that year.

Pentecost is much older than the resurrection of Christ. It is part of the Feast of Weeks, also called the Feast of Harvest. It is described in Lev 23:15-22. This was all foreshadowing the resurrection of the Messiah.

After the main speaker, people were prayed over, and others came to the altar.

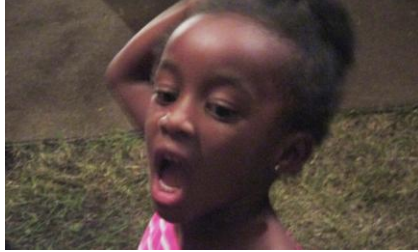

said, "Jesus never stopped loving me. Every one within the sound of my voice, take the relationship with the savior. This is where you pray. I've never seen God move because of something done right then, but because of what was done before in the secret place. When we press in, we get results.

"This is a tent revival," said David Foster. "Somebody is supposed to get revived. "It is Pentecost!" exclaimed Pastor Dustin Bonds. "We should be excited! Honesty comes only from heaven. Holy Spirit have your way. Your identity is from Jesus Christ. James was his half brother, and before he was saved, James mocked him. Jesus promised, 'build your house on this rock and not on sand. It will stand the flood.' God used James to write this epistle. I'm not preaching legalism, its relationship. When you have that relationship, those things make you sick. That's when legalism goes out the window and relationship comes in. "James said, 'My brothers, count it all joy when you fall into various trials... produces patience... lacking nothing. But let him ask in faith without wavering.' A double-minded man is unstable in all his ways. I'm not saying you're not God's, but you are unstable. On the rock you get stability. Resist temptation and receive the crown of life. When lust conceives, it leads to sin, and sin leads to death. My great grand father used to say, 'White lie? See that chicken poo? It has a spot on it, but its still chicken poo.' Be careful of words. Those stones you've been getting hit in the head with, people are watching for your example - not to throw them back, not to throw words. There is also nonverbal communication. The Holy Ghost showed me that I should be able to walk into a room, and without a word, say everything. Joy is not a feeling, happiness might be, but joy is from heaven and it brings happiness. "Just because a person does not fall out, 'slain in the spirit,' does not mean they are not affected. Do not try to put God in a box. When the real gospel comes, that which we call freedom goes away, but the real freedom begins. Allow sanctification to come forth. A graft is a piece of living tissue surgically implanted. We are grafted in. Tell him, 'I can't do it!' But he can. He can engraft that living tissue in your heart. Job was not as intimate with God in Chapter one as he was in chapter 42. The Holy Ghost engrafs the word into you. That's where that life more abundantly comes in. Be doers of the word and not hearers only. Do not rebuke what is forming in you. Holiness comes through the relationship."

Elaboration on Prophecy

In April at the 7-day revival, Shane Haley spoke on prophecy. We have saved it for now so that we would not have to cut much.

"In Mat 24:32-34," Shane began, "Jesus said, 'learn' the parable of the fig tree.' This is the only one he said to 'learn.' This fig tree was the birth of the nation of Israel. Dan 7:25 says, 'He shall speak pompous words against the Most High, shall wear out the saints of the Most High, and shall intend to change times and law. Then the saints shall be given into his hand for a time, times, and half a time.' The Tanakh says two times and a half (not 3&1/2). In II Pet 3:8, he says a day is as a thousand years and a thousand years is as a day. The Greek word here for day is hemera (hay-mer-ah), meaning one day, a 24 hour period, or the time from dark until dark. Therefore, 2&1/2 times 1000 is 2500. Dan 7:1 begins by identifying the time: the first year of Belshazzar. (Belshazzar was not actually the king; he was the regent, ruling in place of his father, Nabonidus, the son-in-law of Nebuchadnezzar). The first year of the reign of Belshazzar was the year his father went to Arabia, 553-552 BC. Adding 2500 years to 552 BC takes us to 1948, the very year Israel became a nation.

"Dan 10:1 tells us that in the 3rd year of the reign of Cyrus king of Persia, Daniel received a vision. The first year of Cyrus was 537-536 BC. If we add 2500 to the third year, 533 BC, we arrive at 1967, the year that Israel regained control of Jerusalem. The Jews are actually only two tribes, Judah & Benjamin. The remaining ten tribes were taken from Israel by the Assyrians in 725 BC. In 722 BC they were dispersed throughout the empire. Hos 1:10 states that Israel will be the sons of the Living God. No one will know. Christians today are where the Israelites are scattered to. Hos 2:19-20 says, 'You will be my bride,' (know it or not). The name

Ephraim has been used to represent all Israel. Sons will come from the west when he roars.

"My birthday is 9/11. When those buildings came down in 2001, a senator quoted Is 9:10. To understand this passage, you have to read the one before and after it. The Lord used the enemies of Israel against them. Today the Syrian refugees have flooded the western nations. Rev 12:14 says that the woman (Israel) will be carried by the wings of an eagle to her place for 2 & ½ times (2500 years) from the presence of the serpent. The year the Israelites were dispersed was 724 BC. 724 + 2500 comes to 1776, America became a nation (the 2 eagle wings). The Lord told Daniel in Dan 12:4 to seal up the book until the time of the end. 1260 days, if these are years, 1948 - 1260 = 688. AD 688 is the very year the Dome of the Rock was built. The roots of Islam began with Ishmael. Gen 16:12 says his hand shall be against every man, and every man's hand against him. He shall dwell in the presence of all his brethren. Isaac and Ishmael were half brothers. Muslims all over the world, especially in Europe have an average of 8 children, while Europeans have an average of 1.5 children. On 15 Jan 2017, 70 nations (the united nations) proposed a **forced** two-state solution for Israel and Palestine. Obama's parting gift to Israel was to refuse to veto this **forced** solution. These 70 nations represent the 70 descendants of Noah (Noah) described in Genesis. The United States has always vetoed this kind of thing, but not Mr Obama. Zech 12:2-3 tells that God will make Israel a very heavy stone around the necks of all nations, who will rise against it. Every college campus, especially in Europe is almost 100% anti Israel. Europe is quickly becoming Muslim. It is all written in the word. Is 17 tells of what is happening **right now** in Damascus. Ezekiel chapters 38 and 39 names three of the major player, Rosh, Meshech, and Tubal - Russia, Turkey and Persia (Iran). Jesus Christ himself said there would be signs in the heavens. Go to the internet and look up what is happening in the heavens. Type in 23 September 2017.

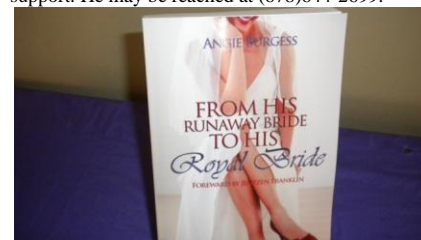

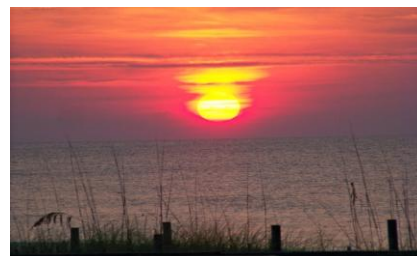
