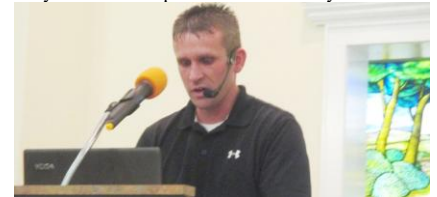

On Prayer 56 Divine Intervention (Part Four)

Let's look at the book of Revelation. Although it is tempting to conclude that scriptural events are unavoidable, yet there is another side to this. Rev 8:1-4 says, "When he opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven for about half an hour. And I saw the seven angels who stand before God, and to them were given trumpets. Then another angel, having a golden censer, came and stood at the altar. And he was given much incense, that he should offer it with the prayers of all the saints upon the golden altar which was before the throne. And the smoke of the incense, with the prayers of the saints, ascended before God from the angel's hand."

The seven trumpets mentioned here are terrible judgments upon the earth. But before any of them can be sounded, the prayers of the saints must first be heard. The angels cannot release judgment until **every prayer** of believers like you and me has been taken into account. Notice that the prayers of all the saints ascend before God as incense before the golden altar. This tells me that the trumpets must line up with the prayers of the saints. If fire falls from heaven, it cannot fall on people who have been prayed for by the saints – they are protected in a pocket of mercy.

Rev 5:1,8 says, "And I saw in the right hand of him who sat on the throne a scroll written inside and on the back, sealed with 7 seals... Now when he [the Lamb] had taken the scroll, the four living creature and the 24 elders fell down before the Lamb, each having a harp, and golden bowls full of incense, which **are** the prayers of the saints."

These 7 seals loose history to occur. Not only was the book unsealed by opening the seals, but the events written in that book were loosed. And the reason the Lord Yeshua was the only one who had authority to open those seals is that he is the only one who has the authority to control history.

Prayer controls both the destiny of individuals and the history of nations. Prayer must be taken into account before the seals are ever opened and the events of history can take place. What a revelation! Your prayers will affect, positively, the individuals for whom you are praying.

"In Mat 24:32-34," Began Shane, "Jesus talks about the fig tree, 'Now learn this parable from the fig tree: When its branch has already become tender and puts forth leaves, you know that summer is near. So you also, when you see all these things, know that it is near – right at the door! Assuredly, I say to you, this generation [the one that sees all these things] will by no means pass away until all these things take place.' This generation will not pass away – the fig tree – the nationhood of Israel. In Dan 7:25, we see the phrase 'time, times & half a time.' Does this mean 3½ years? No! The Tanakh

Does not say time, times, and half a time; it says 2½ times. If Pet 3:8 used the Greek word hemera (heh-mer-ah) and is translated "day," in the King James is "a time," therefore is 2500 years. The first year of the regent Belshazzar was 553 to 552 BC. This was when the dream was given to Daniel. 552 BC plus 2500 years comes to 1948, the year Israel became a nation. This is not a one-time wonder; in Dan 10, we see "in the third year of Cyrus." This year would've been 533 BC. Add the 2500 years and it comes to 1967 – the year that Jerusalem was recaptured by Israel.

Remember, all Jews are Israelites (descendants of Israel), but not all Israelites are Jews. In 725 BC the Assyrians began capturing all of Israel. In 722 BC, all those captured were sent to the area by the Caspian Sea. Hos 1:10 says that the number of the Israelites will be as the grains of sand of the sea, which cannot be numbered. It also says in the same verse, "And it shall come to pass in the place where it was said to them, 'You are not my people,' there it shall be said to them, 'You are sons of the Living God.' The book of Hosea was written to the 10 northern tribes of Israel before their captivity. These are people who do not know they are Israelites. This is because now they are Christians. Hos 2:19 says, "I will betroth you to me forever." V23 says, "I will sow her for myself into the earth... then I will say to them who were not my people, 'You are my people.' In Rev 12:14 it says that the woman was given the wings of a great eagle. The United States is represented by an eagle. By 724 BC all the 10 tribes of Israel were captured. If we add the 2500 years to this, it comes to 1776.

Zech 12:2-3 says, "Behold I will make Jerusalem a cup of drunkenness to all the surrounding peoples, when they lay siege against Judah and Jerusalem. And it shall happen in that day that I will make Jerusalem a very heavy stone for all peoples; all who would heave it away will surely be cut in pieces, though all nations of the earth are gathered against it."

The "abomination that causes desolation" **is** the Dome of the Rock in Jerusalem. So the mark of the beast may not be something that is stamped on you hand or you forehead, but what is **in** you head, in other words, what you believe.

In Gen 1:14, God said the lights in the heavens were for signs and seasons. This Hebrew word for season is Moed (moe-ade), it means appointed time, as in feast days. Watching the stars for signs has nothing to do with witchcraft. It is one of the ways God speaks to us. Jesus said in Luke 21:25, "There will be signs in the sun and the moon and I the stars." At the beginning of the blood moons, ISIS burst onto the scene and Russia moved into Syria. Ps 19:1 says, "The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament shows his handiwork." Rev 12:1-5 may not just be about the birth of Jesus. Rev 2:25-27 says that he who overcomes will receive power over the nations and will rule them with a rod of iron.

The Rapture? In Jewish culture, the groom and his father prepared a place for the married couple to live. No one knew when it would be finished, but as soon as it was, the announcement was made. I Thes 5 talks about the times and the seasons: "But you, brethren, are not in darkness that this day should overtake you as a thief." Rev 3:3 says, "...Therefore if you **will not watch**, I will come upon you as a thief..." Watch the news for the signs God is sending.

Is 66:7-8 says, "Before she was in labor, she gave birth: before her pain came, she delivered a male child. Who has heard such a thing? Who has seen such things? Shall the earth be made to give birth in

One day?" Could the birth be the rapture and the birth pains be the tribulation? I Thes 5:9 says, "For God did not appoint us to wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ." I Pet 2:9 says, "But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, his own special people." I Cor 5:8 says, "Let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, nor with the leaven of malice and wickedness."

Rev 2:10 says, "Do not fear any of those things you are about to suffer. Indeed, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison." Rev 3:10 says, "Because you have kept my command to persevere, I also will keep you from the hour of trial which shall come upon the whole world."

These Truths

Those of you who know me best, know how much I love history, love church history and the history of revivals world wide, but especially, revivals in America. Therefore, the ongoing feud that has come about in our nation has grieved me. This nation, where I am called to preach the gospel, is the jewel of my prayers. I tell you that we, as Americans in our day, do not realize how blessed we are.

The similarities today and those of over 150 years ago are many. The number of casualties accumulated are estimated to be close to 700,000 dead. One side, the north, denounced Southerners for slavery and would not hear the Southerner speak, would not try to understand and work with him to help the nation. The Southerner would denounce the Northerner as "an infidel" because he did not believe the Bible to be Gods word. Accusations rang back and forth. But when did dialogue really cease? As has always been with this great nation, "As goes the church so goes the nation." In 1837 the northern Presbyterians separated from the southern. In 1844 the Methodists did the same. In 1845 the Baptists in the north and south denounced each other and divided. Meaningful dialogue ceased and was replaced with a demonization of one another. Sound familiar?

Northern media denounced southerners as ignorant and weak-minded. Southern media denounced northerners as "Red Republicans," Infidels, and Atheists," just to name a few of the labels. Southerners saw the federal government as tyrannical and blasphemous.

Pastors in the south wrote articles and pamphlets defending slavery and denouncing the "treacherous" north. "Northern ships bring us slaves then they denounce us for buying Them." Revivalists in the North would not come to the south to preach, believing southerners "unworthy to hear the gospel."

It seems to be the "calling" of the media to divide, to create suspicion and ill will among political parties and races, but it is the calling of the Church of Jesus Christ to preach the gospel of reconciliation. We were first divided from God and Jesus had to pay the price for us to be reconciled. If we are not reconciled to God, how can we be reconciled to each other?

I do not pretend to have the answer, but I can assure you it will be found in Him, or history teaches us that it will be found in blood. We will see an awakening that unites us, or we will see devastation.

Reconciliation must begin with us, must begin with Gods people, must begin when we put His kingdom first, and not any political kingdom, or any historical

Kingdom. No matter the cost, we **must** seek first His Kingdom. And we **must** be willing to defend our brothers' right, or sisters' right to speak, to share, to say things that we may not agree with; not because we desire an outcome, but because we **are**

our brothers keeper, we are our sisters keeper, no matter the color of their skin, no matter their political view. If we divide and demonize, then we, the Church, make the same mistake made in 1837, in 1844 and in 1845. We, Americans, and especially Christian Americans, hold these truths to be self evident: that all men are created equal (each equally loved by God). May we see an awakening that will make the words "one nation under God, indivisible, with liberty and justice for all" mean something.

Let it be so.

We are called for something else as well. We are called to do the work that it takes to bring the whole body of Christ into one body, as the Bible tells us to. There are groups of Christians around the state, around the country and around the world that exist to do this very thing and they need **your** help because we are **all** called to do this. In John 17:20-21, Jesus himself prayed, “I do not pray for

these alone, but also for those who will believe in me through their word; that they all may be one, as you, Father are in me, and I in you; that they also may be one in us, that the world may believe that you sent me.”

People, we need to stop acting as if the kingdom of God is all about **our** church and what **our** church is doing, as if we were the only ones headed to the kingdom.

Brother Rick Hempton told a story of what happened when his daughter asked Christ into her life. The world can never know that as long as we are as divided as we are, especially in America.

Not only must we stop the sectarianism, not only must we get okay with those Christians that don't worship, or meet, or sing, or pray like we do, but we must come together and work for this unity we are told by the word of God that we are to have. It takes work to bring the body into one – hard work. The harvest is ready, but the laborers are few.

There is a group of churches in Barrow, Jackson, Walton, Oconee, and Clarke Counties that exists to do this work. It is the **Whole Body of Christ Alliance**. There are other alliances as well, like **One People Ministries**, operating in Georgia, Ohio, Arizona & Texas. I am **not** talking about ecumenicalism. 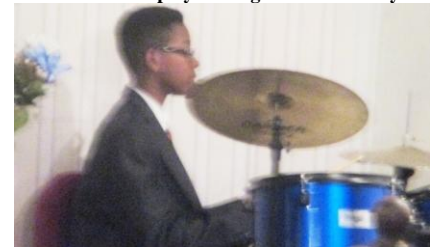

He told the story of his daughter Rachel, who was 30 years old. "She was contemplating marrying a guy who was pursuing her. She asked me what I thought she should do. We both knew that the man really loved her, but I could tell that she might just be afraid that, if she did didn't grab this guy, there might not be another. She said she didn't want to be like Aunt Vicki, who was 60 and still single. I explained to her that she should not make a decision out of fear. My advice to her was to ask God and trust him. Next thing you know, my son mentioned the teacher in his Bible class, how the young teacher should go meet Rachel, how sharp this teacher was, and how my son really liked him. Fast forward to today they are married with two kids. God ordained it. The sovereignty of God is wonderful.

"In waiting on God, delays are not denials If you are praying and praying, it's not time yet. He is listening. Are you worried about your future? You don't have to fear anything, He's got you. Isaiah 41, do not fear or be anxious over what's going to come next. Trust in his power.

When God delays, he shows mercy - double mercy, as in Isaiah 61:7 - double. In the end of Job they prayed for his fruits and God doubled what he had taken away. In 1998, at the Promise Keepers, God told me that I would be meeting in stadiums. I thought it was nuts. God started moving. I wrote that book. The elders said, 'You can preach, but don't come in the office.' They paid me to write and publish the book. It was weird; I would do my sermon preparation, and I would think, 'Lord don't let them fire me.' Three weeks after writing and publishing the book, I was canned. So we stepped out into a men's ministry. We hired eight or 9 people. It was insane. We did five major conferences in five big cities, through the promise keepers. Then they decided to put it off another year, and there was nothing coming in. I asked God, 'what are you doing? We are clearly leading now, but we are dying financially.' I was so depressed and puzzled and thought about pulling the plug. I asked God if there was sin in my life, to

show me. We were \$100 k in the hole. I remember walking to the front door so depressed, thinking, 'I don't get this, I got up early, I got my coffee, I got my Bible, and I can't even read because there's such a weight on me.' One hour later, the phone rang, and a donation check for \$200 k came in from a guy in North Carolina. It still gives me chills. I never asked the man, but for some reason, without me asking, he was prompted to send a check to double the mercy."

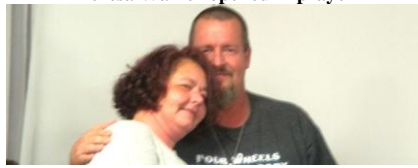

federal law in the US. Be cautious because, remember, we serve a **king**. Stop trying to make everything democratic. In the **kingdom** of God, you will not vote on **anything**. Where did the real *Separation of Church and State* begin? I will put the law of God before the law of the US. The United States is being evil. If I am saying it, I am living it. We are not supposed to practice what we preach; we are supposed to preach what we practice.

“Dan 7:1, America is not the only country God cares about. [Nabonidus married the daughter of Nebuchadnezzar. Nabonidus was actually king of Babylon, but was out of the country. His son Belshazzar ruled as regent in his absence.] V₂, this year we have had more winds moving on the seas than ever before. Every one of those in the Atlantic began in Africa. In 2017 there have been more category five hurricanes than ever on record. This was prophesied. V₃, four beasts from the sea; could these be represented by hurricanes? Something is happening. Remember in Gen 1, God gave **man** the dominion. God never intended for you to be ruled by a government. God never even let the rain come until man could work. In Hebrew, work means ‘become.’ I don’t **do** the work, I **am** the work. We wait on the government to do it, but Jesus said the **kingdom** of God is at hand. It is a kingdom we cannot comprehend because we think in terms of democracy. A kingdom is not a democracy.

“V₄, a lion with eagle’s wings. England is represented by a lion and the United States by an eagle. The eagle’s wings were plucked off the lion—think about that one for a moment. The lion was made to stand on two legs like a man. When we

make allegiance to a government that is not our government, that’s where religion comes in – when we do not understand kingdom. The lion was given a man’s heart, in other words, an evil heart. I have to tell the truth so people don’t go to hell.

“V₅, Russia is represented by a bear. The three ribs may represent the three philosophies obtained by the Russians.

“V₆, this is the leopard, which may be Japan. China cannot stand them.

“Courage comes from the Holy Ghost. This is the reason why the church is in trouble, because we try to run the church like the government. Taking prayer out of schools crippled us because we are not kingdom-minded. In the courtyard of the high priest Peter was afraid of a young girl, but later, after he was filled with the Holy Ghost, he stared down the whole Sanhedrin.

“There comes a time when we must act and walk in a kingdom mind. There are 613 laws of God, but the US has 23,000 pages of federal laws. Jesus said all the law and the prophets are based one two laws. The laws do not talk about the rocket’s red glare, or the bombs bursting in air – sorry. He said love God with all that is in you and love your neighbor as yourself. Most who have been in the military know it is against the flag codes to wear clothing of the flag, but we split the church over someone kneeling at the national anthem, something there is no law against. I want to win my brothers, not offend them. We have to get back in the word to get away from ignorance. We are the church, we are to fix these things. We are to take the kingdom to the world. We can’t do that with all this foolishness.”

'My beloved.' Life application. There were two ladies, leaders, and Paul said 'true companion, help these women.' They labored with him, sowed into his ministry. Your ministry is full-time, maybe at the job site, at Starbuck's, everywhere.

"During the feast of Tabernacles, six days of the week they would carry huge pitchers of water to celebrate. On the 7th day they would empty the pitchers. Jesus said, 'I am the water.' We are celebrating the fruit harvest, pouring out to the Lord, praying, preparing. God of seasons is a God of order. This is a season to sow into, so give cheerfully. Only remember, everything belongs to God. The Earth is his. He is not going to beg for your money. It's time to bless, be good and cheerful givers. When we have an opportunity to give we should be happy and celebrate. The spirit is the water to fill you up, the drought is over."

"We are trying to get the Bibles back in the schools," Jason said. How about we just send a wrapped up ball of the word in the flesh? It is so inspiring to see those kids praying for one another and believing. If that doesn't get you, I'm not sure what will. This is the kind of thing that we need to see in this time. We need to stop magnifying the problem. We have to take the authority. You are the church - sons and daughters of God your identity is a child of God. The problem is that church is a social gathering, and too many church leaders are not equipping, teaching, training, and activating the body into who God called them to be. If you want to find offense, just go to the house of God, because the enemy hates unity. The harvest is abundant, but pray for laborers. By getting in either of these two ditches, we give the enemy the upper hand. The Bible is not silent on warfare. God did not call his people to sit in a pew or check off a box

every week. If you have a pulse you can be used.

"God is doing something in this region, and you are here for such a time as this. I'm equipping you and calling you to engage. The darkness no longer has authority over you, you are no longer bound. I plucked you out and put you into the Kingdom. You are a child of God. Take authority over the battlefield of your mind."

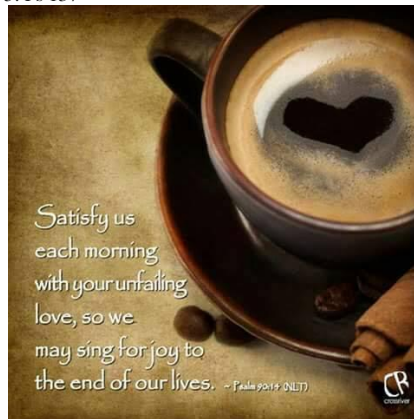

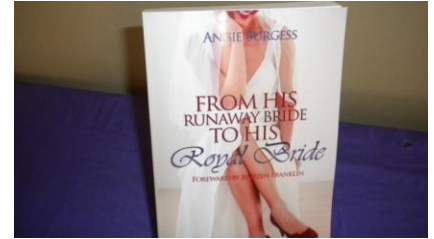
