On Prayer 68 Persevering in Prayer (Part Four)

We have never actually prayed as the Savior prayed. Yeshua's prayer in the place like a garden called Gat-Sh'manim (Gethsemane) was so intense that his sweat pores dripped blood (hemataphoresis), and an angel had to come from heaven to strengthen him (Luke 22:43-44). He might've died right there if the angel had not come to help him through the grief he felt from looking into that cup. Satan probably would've been fine with a premature death so that Jesus couldn't die for our sins.

Yeshua saw all the sins that we have committed – all the sins of every age and every continent. Sins on top of sins were zeroed in on the cup of death that he had to drink. Sustained by an angel, praying in intensity and perseverance, Yeshua HaMeshiakh won the victory at Gethsemane. That's why he had the ability to persevere and not faint the next day.

There would've been no Golgotha (Calvary) without Gat-Sh'manim (Gethsemane). Yeshua looked into that cup with all its horrible contents and prayed his way to victory. That's why he had such peace the next day. That's how he could hang on the cross and say, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do." How did he have that kind of tranquility? He had prayed through the agony and the heartbreak.

The reason we don't take up our cross is because we have skipped the prayer meeting. We faint because we have skipped Gethsemane. We don't have victory over sin because we haven't sweat drops of blood in the garden of prayer. The Lord is our example of perseverance and intensity.

Some people don't believe in praying twice. Jesus went back three times. The first two times he said, "Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me." The Father said it wasn't possible. Either he went to the cross died, or all people would go to hell. The third time, with blood dripping from his pores, he said triumphantly, "Not my will, but yours, be done." He rose to victory right then and there. The next day he walked out the victory.

We try to walk it out without the prayer meeting. We make a quick, simplistic prayer and then wonder why we can't carry through to victory. The deeper we pour out our heart, the more intense our intercession becomes. Then the straighter our walk and more obedient our steps will be.

I used to think I would never quit. I couldn't tolerate quitters. If someone fell, I could understand, but not if they quit. I took pride in the fact that I was not a quitter. Of course I did not recognize that it was pride. I assumed that the reason I wasn't a quitter was because I was such a strong person.

Mat 23:12 says, "Whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted." So the devil went to work on me until I wanted to quit constantly.

Now I understand that the only reason I was strong was the grace of God. It had nothing to do with my personality. The Bible teaches that we stand by grace. Our strength doesn't come out of our self-righteousness, our attainment, our fortitude, our determination, or **our** strength. When we go through the devil's wringer, we find out that our strength is the Lord's and not our own.

If you feel like quitting and are tired of persevering, God is showing you that you stand only by his grace. Call on him and ask for his help. You will find strength in the same place that Jesus did – in the garden, in the quiet place, even when your three best friends can't stay awake. When there is nobody else to pray but you, you receive strength in perseverance and intercession. And once you have it, you will say, "My strength is the Lord."

"You therefore, beloved, since you know beforehand, beware lest you also fall from your own steadfastness, being led away with the error of the wicked; but grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ" (II Pet 3:17-18).

every time God reveals his son, the enemy attacks. Are you ready for the revealing? How do we get ready? How do we get past the sins of Adam? Creation is waiting for us to get in position and get things ready. We must see ourselves as God sees us (John 3:16). We are redeemed of sin as well as the accusations of the enemy. We are redeemed through the blood of Yeshua. What was lost in the garden? It was our relationship with the Father. Jesus can restore this. The cross is important, but it is not the end of the story. He rose with power to

restore us to the kingdom. We must not just praise him in the courtyard. This place is not filled with

people tonight. People want to be entertained. *Oh, How I Want to Be Like Jesus*. The old mothers used to sing that.

“Yeshua humbled himself in obedience. The first thing that came was humility. We must humble ourselves like Jesus. In that humility he was able to obey. Have we humbled ourselves like Jesus?”

I Pet 1:13-16, the revealing; we miss things because we just read and/or memorize the word instead of studying it. We read about the full armor of God in Ephesians 6, and don’t realize we are putting on Jesus himself. The demons of Legion could find nothing of themselves in Yeshua and they left. If Satan comes, let there be nothing of him in me. I must stop **trying** to be righteous. God says, ‘I got this.’ When we put on that full armor, the enemy can find nothing of himself in us and must leave.

“What are the consequences of not surrendering completely? King Nebuchadnezzar was having dreams and told the sages to tell **him** the dream. He was killing them because they could not. In Dan 2:47 he said, ‘Your God is the God of gods.’ Of all the pagan kings, Nebuchadnezzar acknowledged God. In Dan 4:1-3, he praised God. Nebuchadnezzar was special to the Lord. Why did Babylon prosper under Nebuchadnezzar? When God’s children disobeyed, he used Nebuchadnezzar to get them in line. If not for Nebuchadnezzar, Daniel and the three young men would never have been there so God could use them. He came out of favor with God when he started acting like Satan. It was the same thing with Adam and Khavah (Eve). Adam and Eve didn’t have to do anything – just tend. They had it made. This was the God they had a relationship with. So there are many example of what happens when we start acting like Satan.

“The Amalekites always came against the will of God. Pride is an Amalekite. When God gets ready to do something, pride comes (Amalekites). The root of pride and of arrogance is fear – ‘I’m the greatest – an Amalekite. Satan will use all those gateways to anything in us our soul to keep you from the revealing. Nebuchadnezzar’s lycanthropy came from his prideful, puffed-up boasting. He was a lycanthrope for 4 to 7 years. For Nebuchadnezzar, it was a generational curse. If you operate in pride, Satan has a legal right to your blood line. Belshazzar was so arrogant that he had a party while the Persians were outside the walls of Babylon. This disrespect and arrogance came from his grandfather, Nebuchadnezzar – the generational curse. He was drinking from the temple cups, saw the handwriting on the wall, and had to send for Daniel. The Amalekite of pride destroyed Belshazzar. So don’t keep blaming the devil for things you are responsible for.

“Get ready for the great reveal, every thing in us that is not like our daddy. The Amalekites cause disunity; they have to go. The pride manifesting in us is causing the enemy to have legal right to take us out.

“Stop the behavior modification – don’t do this, do that, be good. There are things in us lying dormant in our souls that give the enemy a legal right to attack us. The spirit was redeemed, the soulish realm was saved, but still needs deliverance. Deal with the toms down in our souls. Behavior modification does not work. Just deal with the things in the soulish realm. You must have the

mind of Christ. We want God to do a total overhaul. Get low. If I want the people delivered, it starts with me.

“Eph 4:25, Stop telling lies, stop stealing, in your anger, do not sin, do not allow any unwholesome talk come out of your mouth, or any coarse jokes. Put on humility. To be ready for the big reveal, you must put on Christ with his word – his logos and his rhema – those things he reveals to **you**.

“Are you going to be ready? It’s time to make a decision. We can’t keep dancing outside the gate. Let him remove all desires that are not from him, evict anything not from him.”

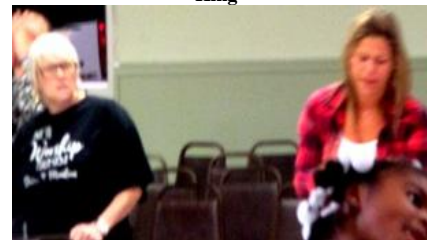

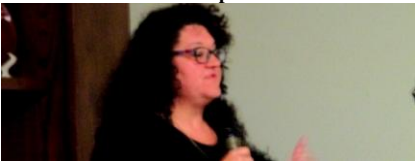

or wrath? Are you able to drink from the cup? It can even contain death. The cup will eventually bring each one of us to our knees. It is something you will go through and have gone through. Stand!

The cup is the test before the testimony, the mess before the message, the bad before the good. We preach the gospel. Death is bad, but then comes the resurrection. The cup precedes the crown. Everybody wants the crown, but nobody wants the cup. It must come before your promotion. We want to skip Gethsemane, but the blessing does not come until after the trial. We wanna go straight to the crown. In Rev 17:4 it says of the woman on the scarlet beast, 'She held a golden cup in her hand, filled with abominable things and the filth of her adulteries.' You can't just sip; you have to drink the whole thing.

"Jesus had to drink the whole thing. Job had to lose everything because of the cup, but it meant a crown

later on.

"Have you ever asked God, 'Why has this all happened at once, not just a little, but this, that and the other?' God says, 'If you just swallow it, it will make you feel better.' You say, 'In my walk with the Lord I should be past this by now. Lord, why me and why now?' God will answer, 'Didn't you tell me, 'Lord, I want to serve you. Use me. I want the anointing? Didn't you know there was a price to pay, a cup to drink?'" But everybody cannot go where you are going. It is **your** season of elevation. They cannot all be with you in this season because before the blessing, the cup is waiting for you.

"Sometimes you have to leave people down there when you go up. If not you may bring a curse on what God is trying to give you.

"God said, 'I asked you if you were able to drink the cup and you answered, 'I am.'" You might have the cup, but don't give up. Trust the opportunity for God to blow your mind. God is about to take the church through the fire because it has been served the cup. Everybody cannot drink it. Weeping may be in the evening, but joy will come in the morning. Your blessing will come in the morning. When everyone walks away from you, or stabs you in the back, it is not their season. They may say, 'Pastor, I love you,' and when it comes time, you look around and, where did they go? It is not their season. Jesus looked around and said, 'Where did they go?' It was not their season.

"When God gives you a gift and you don't use it, you still get to keep it because the gifts are without repentance. He said of Jezebel, 'Have I not given her time to repent?' When you are chosen, you can run all you want, but God himself will come for you and you're not gonna like the way he shows up.

"An empty barrel makes a lot of noise, but a barrel that is full does not. God has to pour you out to be able to fill you. Then you say, 'Where is God?' And God says, 'Get alone with me.' If you don't hear God that is when he is calling you to get alone with him. Then your cup will run over.

"The farmer just works in the daytime and trusts God to make the crops grow. God, however, works also at night. Trust God and he will get you to a place that only he can get you to.

"Gideon got his breakthrough over Midianites in the dark. Job did not know where God was, but God knew where Job was. When you are going through it, you really know who is with you. God had his eyes on Job the whole time and if he will do it for Job, he will do it for us.

"God is controlling the temperature of the fire you're going through because he is the refiner. How does he know when we are ready? He knows we are ready when he can see his reflection in the silver. God is in the process of giving the church a bowell movement.

"You don't know who the Christians are anymore; they look too much like the world. Come out from among them, even if it costs you this life. It is the cup experience. It's like playing hot potato: you don't want to have the potato when the music stops or you're out of the game. When we were kids, we cried when we had the hot potato. People cry when they get the cup because they think the music has stopped. You say, 'Lord, have your way.' Really? Never pray for patience; pray for love because without love, it doesn't matter how much patience you have.

"Ya'akov (Jacob) sent his sons to Egypt not knowing that Joseph was in charge. Joseph had his special cup. He was a type and shadow of Jesus. There are 33 comparisons of Joseph to Jesus and Jesus died when he was 33. Joseph placed his cup in the bag of Benjamin. God will place a cup for you for your growth.

"Benjamin did not know how the cup got in his sack. I don't know, Sister Mary, how I got these bed bugs. I don't know, Pastor Walker why my

house burned down. It is because God had to start you over. He placed a cup to change your plans. When God serves you a cup, it comes with a directional change. We are to interpret the prophecy. Maybe next year God will show up in all his glory.

"After the cup, people change their direction. The cup brought the brothers back into the presence of Joseph. The cup will always lead you back into the presence of God. Being churchified is when you get so busy in the church that you are not hearing God because the word says this and that – No! Just come to his house, sit and wait until he moves. He is looking for people who will be obedient. There will be people who will come in at the last days and say, 'This place is out of order.' How can that be when God said, 'I am doing a new thing?'"

"That is why I left the denominations. I don't care who does the offering or who sings. Maybe you have not been served the cup yet. God is looking for humility – the fruit of our lips, giving praise to him, glorifying his name. Do you wanna get God's attention? Start praising, worshiping him, raising your hands. If you want a pity party, go to your room; we are not gonna party with you. If you wanna worship, we will be with you.

"With new levels come new devils. With new anointing comes new responsibility. In the WBCA we preach unity. If there is none in your home or your home church, you will not have it anywhere else. You may be sad now, but hold onto the cup. You may be discouraged, but hold onto the cup. It will bring you into the presence of God. The cup may not look good or taste good, but hold onto that cup because, if you have questions for God, he is the only one who can answer."

“It is a matter of loving our neighbor as our self,” said Deputy Chief of Police Jeff Clark. “Matthew 22:37-39, Jesus replied: ‘Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the greatest commandment. And second is like it: Love your neighbor as yourself.’ Treat everybody the same, being fair and impartial. The world needs to live like the church. We need more meetings like the forum often. Many times when you attend certain meetings people are filled with hate. But I feel the Holy Spirit and love in here. In Genesis it talks about how we are all made in God’s image. You have to have the love of Christ. Wisdom is knowledge, knowledge is power. Jesus went to the cross because he loved us. That gives us our identity. Eph. 2:1-9, By grace through faith we have been saved and entered into the kingdom of God. We sit with Christ in heavenly places. Christ saved us and raised us up to sit with him. It is not our own doing, but a gift from God. It is not a result of our own works. In us we can do nothing, but through Christ we can do great things. Rev 7:9, ‘After this I looked, and behold, a great multitude that no one could number, from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the lamb. They were clothed in white robes, with palm branches in their hands.’”

“These meetings are so very important to our

community,” Mayor Kelly Girtz exclaimed. “It was a decision for us to come here today and encourage harmony. I am grateful to be here. Racial harmony has no color. My dream is that we all can work together. Pull the resources together than we can work in harmony.”

Pastor Solomon Smothers, There are places people don’t want to go, like the cemetery and like church.”

The panel was very enjoyable and quite different from the other meetings. Unity in the body of Christ stems from a heart issue. When you give your life to Christ and you are born again, you should have a changed heart. A heart change sees no color and no difference in the body of Christ. When we truly learn to walk as Christ walked, loving our neighbors as ourselves, we should have no problem with unity. Unity sees no race, or color. We may not agree with someone else’s type of religion, but that does not mean we can’t get along. Be the good Samaritan. Don’t pass your neighbor by. Who is your neighbor? Anyone who needs your assistance is your neighbor.

After the panel members were finished, the small groups discussed some of the things they all talked about. After the panel and small group, Pastor Joyce Heard gave the closing remarks. She ended the meeting by thanking Pastor Hugo for allowing us to have the meeting in his church. She thanked everyone for coming - the panel and the small groups. In closing we sang a song about Unity. Then Pastor Joyce closed the service in prayer.
