On Prayer 75 Intervention by Angels (Part Six)

The book of Revelation is a drama of angels, with 71 references to angels in its 22 chapters. One hundred million angels sang praise to the Lamb. Four angels were given the power to hurt the earth. An angel sealed the 144,000. An angel responded to the prayers of the saints in Rev 8. It was an angel that loosed 200,000,000 Euphratian horsemen. Michael (pronounced **Mikh**-ah-el, not My-kul) and his angels war against the dragon and his angels. There is tremendous angelic warfare in heaven (Rev 12).

Angels proclaim three terrible announcements in Rev 14:6-19. One of them is what happens to those who worship the beast. An angel will bind Satan and throw him into the bottomless pit for a thousand years. (Notice it only takes one angel)

Angels are the dispensers and the administrators of divine benefits. They undertake our defense, regard our safety, and direct our ways. Angels were created by God for the service of the community of Messiah. Created with higher knowledge, power, and mobility than men, angels are God's servants who carry out his orders in this world and assist him in his sovereign power over the universe. Multitudes of angels, indescribable in might, perform the commands of heaven, keeping in contact with everything occurring on earth so they can help control and work out the destinies of both individuals and nations.

During one of our morning worship services in October 2014, the Lord gave me the following prophecy: "For you sow not in the earthly realm, but you sow in the heavenly realm. For the one that praises his God shall reap angelic help, shall reap angelic covering. For the one who is a worshiper draws angels to his assistance. For my angels are worshipers. When you receive Messiah and acknowledge him publicly, Yeshua shouts your name across the corridors of heaven. He is saying, "This one has switched kingdoms and asked for me to be their king. All of you who make up the armies of heaven must now protect, guide, and watch over this one because they are mine."

If you have never made a public commitment to Jesus, at your very first opportunity eagerly and excitedly run forward in some church or public service and confess Jesus Christ as your personal Lord. When you do this, then the Lord Yeshua HaMashiakh, himself, owns you as his, publicly, in heaven. From that point on, the innumerable, supernatural angels will come to your aid, guide your life, assist your marriage, and watch over your life because you are an heir of salvation.

Ping Pong Balls (Part Two)

Even a native in some jungle in the most remote part of the world sees that which was created and **knows** that he did not create it. He will, therefore, worship some God that, in his mind, did create it. We will **all** worship something, whether it is the true and Living God, the sun, the moon, science or Darwinism.

Rom 1:21-27, "For even though they knew God (ie knew he was real) they did not honor him as God, or give thanks; but they became futile in their speculations (for example teaching something as ridiculous as 'man descended from apes,' rather than give credit to God), and their foolish hearts were darkened, **professing to be wise, they became fools...** ...God gave them up to vile passions for even their women exchanged the natural use for what is against nature (lesbianism). Likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust for one another... (Paul wrote this around the autumn of 57 AD. Sounds like today, right?) Most of the "geniuses" in the scientific community will go out of their way to try to discredit anyone in that community that worships Almighty God.

God gives us **substance** and **evidence**, not only by what was created, but in our own individual lives. If we choose to blind ourselves to what has been placed right in front of us again and again, just as it says in Romans, we become fools. It is not my purpose to belabor the ridiculousness of the immense lack of real evidence, nor the presentation of the contrived evidence presented by many "scientists" for the case of Darwinism. Nor is it my purpose to treat any of the ridiculous existential questions like, "Do we really exist?" Anyone who wants to dwell on those thing can see me later and I will point you in the right direction. Right now I am dealing with the subject of **faith** to Christians.

We see from Rom 12:3 that we are to think of ourselves realistically in accordance with the **measure of faith** God has dealt to everyone. We are all capable of the kind of faith spoken about in Heb 11:6. Where I want to go now is our

misunderstanding about the faith **beyond** that simple ability to believe.

We said that faith simply means belief – accepting as true those things that God has revealed to us in his word – both with his logos and his rhema – fairly simple. But what does seem more complicated – at least it used to puzzle me – is the fact that Christians regard faith, in this sense, as a virtue. I used to ask, "How in the world can it be a virtue? What is there moral or immoral about believing or disbelieving a set of statements?" I used to say, "Obviously, a sane man accepts or rejects any statement, **not** based on whether he **wants** to or not, but on whether the evidence is good or not." (There's that substance and evidence again.) "If he were mistaken about the quality of the evidence, it would not make him a bad man. It would only mean that he was not very intelligent. And if he thought evidence was bad, but tried to force himself to believe it anyway, he would merely be stupid."

The fact is that I still take that same view. But what I did not see then, and many people do not see is this: I assumed that once the human mind accepted something as true, that it would continue to do so, unless real reason for reconsideration surfaced. I assumed that the human mind was completely ruled by logic – by reason. This was an invalid assumption. Allow me to demonstrate.

When I was young and learning to swim, it was demonstrated to me that a normal human body, lungs filled with air, and not flailing around, will actually float on water. I could see the reason, the logic in it. I saw it to be true. I believed it because there was **substance** to it. The **evidence** had been demonstrated. When they let go of my hand in deep water, however, something else gripped me – panic. Panic is a complete loss of reason and logic. It took practice to overcome my lack of reason and logic. With practice, I learned not to panic.

My reason, my logic is completely convinced by solid evidence that anesthetics do not smother me, and that properly trained surgeons do not start operating until I am completely unconscious. But that does not change the fact that, when they have me on the table waiting to have surgery, a childish panic begins inside of me. I become terrified that they are going to begin cutting on me before I am completely under. In other words, I lose my **faith** in anesthesiologists – a faith that is based on reason. It is not my logic or reason that is taking away my faith: on the contrary, my faith is **based** on reason. Instead the culprits are my imagination and emotions.

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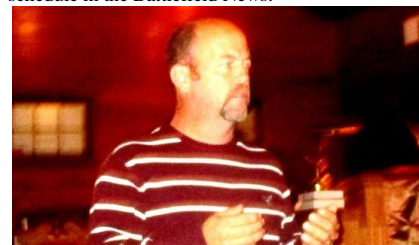
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Christian Physicians under the Great

blessing in sowing and reaping, but the Kingdom life isn't about "how can God make me rich". But even greater news is that this article isn't about that either. What I want to convey and **emphasize** is the "Open Window" that we claim to be under. Several different times throughout biblical history we read about windows that provided a way of escape or even brought forth death. I would like to speak about the latter subject and carefully speak where I see the body of Christ in this prophetic season. Apostles are preaching but are you awake?

Act 20:7-12, "And the first day of the week, when the disciples came together to break bread, Paul preached to them, and because he was going to leave the next day, he continued his word until midnight. And there were many lamps in the upper chamber, where they were gathered together. And a certain young man named Eutychus (in Greek his name means well-fated or fortunate) sat in a window, having fallen into a deep sleep; and as Paul preached on and on, Eutychus sunk down with sleep and fell down from the third floor and was taken up dead. And Paul went down and fell on him and, embracing him, said, "Trouble not yourselves, for his soul is still in him. When Paul went back upstairs again and broke bread and ate and talked a long while, even until day break, he went on his way. And the people took the young man home alive and were greatly comforted."

Paul, in the form of the apostolic anointing is preaching until midnight. We as a Church are in a "Midnight hour". We are in the end-times, the drawing nigh of the return of the Lord.

We are in a pivotal time of transition where we will either see the beautiful bride awaken into her fullness or decline into greater moral and spiritual decay. His hand is at the door and the sounding of the trumpet is about to blast the heavenly realm wide open. It is time for true apostolic preaching and power to come forth in the body like never before. The "breaking of bread" and the fellowship of the Saints – We have all been made partakers of the divine by the blood of Jesus. His broken body has provided the way for every believer to partake of the Kingdom freely. Many of us have heard the Kingdom message being preached the past 10 years or more, but the missing ingredient within the message has been a true lack of humility and of

being broken pieces of bread ourselves. Jesus said that without him you can do nothing, but somewhere in the mix we have seen countless prophetic voices rising up "making a name for themselves" this is coming to an end. The day of the dog and pony show are coming to an end in the body of Christ. God desires to move us from spectators to demonstrators in the last hour. This is not to say He isn't going to use the fivefold ministry but what we have seen as the fivefold taking place is far from the heart of the Father.

Many lamps but little oil – lamp stands represent churches we see this in Rev 2:2-5. The upper room is a type and shadow of the place of waiting; it was in the upper room that the disciples tarried until they were filled with the oil of Heaven. Little tarrying is taking place across the world; we have many churches but little oil. You cannot drive fifteen miles in the south without passing 20

churches. Again I say "Many lamps but little oil". But there is a "gathering" of the saints taking place – those who are sick of church as usual.

Eutychus is sitting in the window.

Eutychus name means "well-fated," or should I say "well-fatted?" Because the church is **fat** with **knowledge**. And we know that knowledge puffs up, but love edifies. Jesus said that the world would know us by our love for one another. There are many workers but not enough lovers in the Kingdom. Lovers lay down their lives, expecting nothing in return. Lovers will drive 100 miles just to pray for one sick person. Lovers will give all that they have just to see souls come into the kingdom. Lovers will tarry at the altar until there is a breakthrough. Lovers will worship without having been asked. Lovers take up their Cross and follow after Jesus. The body is fat with revelation but asleep like Eutychus was when the apostle preached his message. Many hear the word but are

asleep when it comes to doing the word. God's sleeping beauty has been rocked to sleep in the open window of Heaven by talented preachers of word only and no power!

Eutychus fell from the third story – a type of upper heaven revelation, as in the third realm of heaven. We have seen great and mighty men who carried Third heaven revelation fall from great heights within the Body of Christ. But this too is coming to an end. A holy separation is coming to the bride once again where we will no longer see men buckle or compromise under the power of temptation. Paul went down – humility and restoration. He and fell on Etytchus and embraced him; we will see many prodigals come back into the body who were once dead and lost their callings, but apostolic power will raise them back to their rightful place in the Kingdom. **Eutychus will rise from the dead.** It is time for the Church to wake up and go out into the highways and byways and awaken a generation who have yet to encounter Jesus. You are beautiful, yet you are asleep, and it is time to arise and shine forth your light. Get your lamps full of oil and be fit for the Master's return.

suspect they were Christians. A friend once asked me if there was enough evidence to convict me of being a Christian if being a Christian were illegal (which we will probably see in the distant future). I had never heard it put that way before, but it made me become very honest with myself. Was there enough evidence?

"We have all seen that being in unity, real unity, being and acting like we are all one body – the body of Christ – is what the Lord wants, prayed for and has told **us** to accomplish. The rest of the Christian world does not seem to know this, but we in the Whole Body of Christ Alliance know it well. We have been saying to each other since 2010. I want to ask all of you in the same way it was asked

or presented to me: if working to unite the body of Christ were illegal, let us say a capital crime, would there be enough evidence to convict you of it? Is there enough evidence to convict any of us of it? When I am honest with myself, I must answer a "no" to this question, almost every one of us must answer the question in the same way. I thank and praise God that not everyone in this alliance, however, can answer this question in the negative. If I used the fingers of both hands, however, I could count those that would definitely have to hire a defense attorney because they have been caught red-handed working to unite the body of Christ.

I am the pastor of a church, work a full-time job, I serve on the board of directors of the WBCA, am a husband and a father, and more. I am quite busy. I say this because, undoubtedly, there are those that would answer that they are too busy to actually do the work that must be done to unite the body. I promise you, **you** are not busier than I. I have actually heard one pastor say, "We **are** united." Look around you, people. It does not require a genius to see that that statement is a lie.

I have decided to make a commitment. I have decided to endeavor to create the evidence against myself. I want there to be enough evidence to convict me of working to bring about unity in the body of Christ. After all, that is one of the requirements for being part of the alliance – that we be willing to do the work to bring this about. I am making the commitment to actually do the work; not just talk about it. If doing the work becomes a capital crime, I want there to be enough evidence to convict me.

This is the part where I ask you to put your action where your mouth is and make this commitment with me. It does not matter if you do not know how (I don't really believe that anyway), I am going to tell you all you need to know, but **you** will have to get up off the couch, **you** will have to turn off the television, **you** will have to get up off your pew and actually take action – **You!**

There are many who speak in public of things and people, and say, "I'm not going to name any names..." Well, I have a reputation, along with Pastor Michael Smith and a very few others of naming names. I am about to do that now. I am going to volunteer the entire board of directors, including myself to be available to you to tell you what **you** can do. If you do not **know** what to do, one of these people will help you, but **you** must actually pick up the telephone and call one of us. **YOU MUST DO IT!**

"As president of the Whole Body of Christ Alliance, I can tell you it's not about church membership; it's about kingdom citizenship."

"Deut 2:2, 'Then the Lord said to me, "You have made your way around this hill country long enough; now turn northward.'" The Israelites were in Egypt for 430 years, but God is able to do exceedingly, abundantly beyond all we ask or think. We get busy looking at the cares of this world. "Since, in America, we have removed God from the community square and the market place, many of the younger generation does not know who God is. In Acts 17:22, Paul, on Mars Hill at the areopagus addressed the men of Athens, including the followers of Epicurus (341 – 270 BC). The Epicureans, who believed that man was not created and that the gods were far away. They abandoned as hopeless the search for real truth, believing it impossible to find using reason. Instead, they sought true pleasure through experience. This is so much like today, where God is denied and everyone has their own 'truth.'

"The problem with this is that truth is not invented; it can only be discovered. In logic there is a thing called the Law of Noncontradiction, which says that any two things that contradict one another cannot exist simultaneously. It is impossible for something to be 'true' for you if it is not true for me as well. Truth is universal and it is always true. If it is not, then it is not the truth, but only a truism.

"Paul told the men of Athens, who had built a monument to 'the unknown god,' that this one they worshiped whose name they did not know was the God of creation. In the US we are rapidly building a 'monument to an unknown God. The god we don't know is the Lord of

Creation, who does not live in a temple built by men. We are talked about as being 'evolved,' not created because we don't want to be accountable. We are becoming like Europe in that there are huge churches that stand empty. They have become monuments to an unknown God."

I am what God says I am. Jesus did not go to the cross for you to just get by. A bumble bee is not supposed to be able to fly. She does not listen to what 'they' say. We need a bumble bee mentality and stop listening to what 'they' say. Dream big, not just in God, but with God. They may say God is not gonna give you a church. I say that's okay; I have a corn field. Go Northward! Stop going about in circles. If I am down, it makes me look up at God. Go northward and break the generational curses. yours, but God's. We are not supposed to go around with a sour face. You can go to the graveyard for that. If you are a child of the king and God gave you instructions for battle, but you don't carry it out, it's your fault. In my house, if you cause disunity, the popo are gonna come get you. Holiness is not long skirts. You can wear a long skirt and still have a long tongue. In II Chronicles the singers went before the army. There is power in unity, praise, and thanksgiving. If there had been confusion, they would never have won the battle. If we come into unity, into one accord, God will be in our midst. Nothing should ever be done for show. It will draw away the presence of God.



Ms Elise Diaz translates into English for First Lady Rosa Loyless of Aliento de Vida

"In Eph 4:11, the body represents the five offices. The head is Christ, the chest and abdomen is the apostle, the right arm is the prophet, the left arm is the evangelist, the right leg is the pastor, and the left is the teacher.

"I am not saying one is greater than the other; we are supposed to have communion with all believers. Everything in the body is placed together. I can function without my arm if I have to, but I need it. I can lose both legs, but is the body complete? We need one another. What if the prophet is against the teacher or the evangelist against the prophet? Are all against Christ? We need the body of Christ to be a full body. People pass by and they could come in, but they see the body fighting.

"The body is walking around with all kinds of spirits, but they are not always the Holy Spirit. If the teacher has the spirit of always fighting, there will be no unity. There is supposed to be communion. So what are we showing all the people and the believers in our church? The teacher wants to be the prophet. The pastor wants to be the apostle. I am before you, but I am not a pastor, but a teacher. The divisions are usually because of our 'doctrines,' and the reason we have many different denominations and people who have left the alliance. The Lord wants us to be in the same spirit, not in the same doctrine because there is no pet doctrine that is worth sacrificing the unity in the body. God really wants unity.

"What is our goal tonight? To fight? To criticize? To talk badly about each other? What do we want to be able to give people? Our pet doctrine? We may not agree, but we don't have to agree to be in unity."



Herman Parks of Alternative View

"By God's Grace one day we will have churches where we can discuss doctrine as easily as you would at work. God is light and love, not one more than the other. It is not that these attributes are characteristic of some part of God. No, his whole being is all of his attributes. Every attribute in scripture is true of all of God. Each attribute is just a way of describing his unity. He is not a just God in the Old Testament and a loving God in the New. All of him is completely consistent with the whole of him.

"Are there some actions of God that are not consistent? Does he set things aside sometimes? Never! That would make him inconsistent with his own character. If Jesus was a created creature, then how could he, no matter how great he was, save us? If he is not fully God, then how can we trust him to save us? If Jesus were not an infinite God, then how could we pray to him and worship him? If he were 'a god,' and some cults such as the Jehovah's witnesses say, then it would be idolatry to worship him – see Rev 5:12-14. By not having Jesus as Lord we have everything to lose and not one thing to gain.

"In John 20:29, T'oma (Thomas), who had already stated that he would never believe that Yeshua had risen from the dead unless he put his hand in the wound on Jesus' side and in the nail holes in his hands, was shown these things and fell to his knees and acknowledged Yeshua as 'my Lord and my God' just before Yeshua (Jesus) told him, 'Because you have seen me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed.' Yeshua did not rebuke T'oma for worshipping him, but blessed him.

"Deut 6:4 is called the Sh'mah (Sh'mah Oh Israel, Adonai Eloheinu, Adonai ehad –hear oh Israel,

The Lord your God, the Lord is one). This statement of Yeshua was a greater blessing for us than it was for T'oma. We did not see what he did.



Karen Sipe of Ruach Adonai Alai

"Baruch Habah b'shem Adonai – blessed is he that comes in the name of the Lord. People are out there in the world and they are saying, 'God, if you are real, if you are out there, where are you?' Unfortunately, most of the churches are not in unity and therefore, people are getting hurt. I used to be Chicken Little. It was Samantha who told me I was gun shy. I'm not going to be shy anymore. I'm going to draw my sword – this word.

"John 17:20-22, now, that is unity – unity first with our Father, then with Yeshua HaMashiakh, then with each other. Why is the theme for this seven-day revival always unity? This is where we get equipped to carry out Mat 28:18-20. That way they can be in unity with us. Where does Yeshua want us to go? We can go sit in church all the time, but this does not help the kingdom of God. For us to be effective, we must be in unity with others out there, others not in our church, but in other churches. We must be in unity. Is your church struggling? Are you struggling? Then tell your family; tell the WBCA. While we are bickering over doctrinal issues, what is the world seeing in us? But is we show them this – this unity, they will want it. I know it works. The people in this room and all the WBCA have shown me the meaning of unity. What we have is real. What those out there need is Jesus first, then us. We must be one, be equipped, be in unity wit each other and with our Messiah. Unity is the greatest commandment – love, unity is love."

"Is 49:1, 'Listen to me you islands; hear this, you distant nations...' God created you for his purposes. You are not an island. You are not alone. We are to be united, not doing our own thing."



Pastor Brant Myerholt of We Have a Hope Ministry

"In 1997 there were the Raggamuffins, a bunch of people who were just sick of church. What a wonderful spirit you have here. In the army, if you shower and eat with and sleep in the same room with people, there will be unity. I remember seeing a sign there, 'In unity there is victory.' Unity is the state of being unified and in the army we never quit and we never left anyone behind. Eph 2:14 was used in the army. The only way we are gonna get through this is together. Unity may not be what you wanna do, but God doesn't care what your agenda is. There will be countless times that you are lost, but somebody else will know the way. Let's not forget to give credit to the one who did it all

anyway. I don't hope that everybody remember me, but I hope that they never forget Jesus."



Rick (Rabbi) Sipe of Ruach Adonai Alai

"Deut 6:1-5 includes the Sh'mah. Acts 4:32, they put feet to their faith. That's what unity is all about – like helping Pastor Carol. These were dead people. It takes a dead person – dead to themselves – to give their Mercedes to someone who needs it. Here in Acts chapter four they were doing what it says in Deut 6. In I Corinthians something had happened that Paul had to address. It is the same thing that is happening today; we would let the world into our church. In Acts 4, the world was not part of the church. Gal 5:16-25, we need to be walking in the spirit. If we are led by the Spirit, then we are not in subjection to the system that results from perverting the Torah into legalism. Jesus trusted the Holy Spirit, so I know I am supposed to as well. Spiritual mothers and fathers produce accountability. To my spiritual father, I take off my shoes and say, 'Step on my toes until I am back where I am supposed to be. That is what they did in the early church.'"



Jeff Cornelius of Christ the King

"The Battlefield News is a ministry and a tool. God will use us and the printed pages. I love it in color. Why should we support it? The Lord wants us to win souls; this is a tool for that. It is very informative, but winning souls is most important.

"Back during WWII Jacob DeShazer's mother was part of the Methodist Church. He attended church, but it was not his thing. So while he was trying to figure out what his thing was, he joined the army. The Pearl Harbor happened. America was plunged into war and Jacob was in the air corps. The American reprisal was the Dolittle raid, which Jacob was a part of. He was shot down and was a Japanese prisoner of war for the rest of the war. It was as a Prisoner of war that Jacob asked for Jesus to be his Lord. After the war Jacob went to seminary and returned to Japan to bring the gospel to those who had held him prisoner. Jacob began a publication much like the Battlefield News.

"The Japanese officer that led the raid on Pearl Harbor was Captain Mitzuo Fachita. A man was handing out copies of Jacob's publication at a train station and Captain Fachita got a copy. He read a story by this man who had been a prisoner in a Japanese prison camp who asked Jesus into his life. Mitzuo asked Jesus into his life too and the two men met as Christian brothers.

"The Lord wants this, whether it goes to the corner or the other side of the world. It does not matter if someone in Indonesia knows you supported it or that Dr Rick put his heart into it."

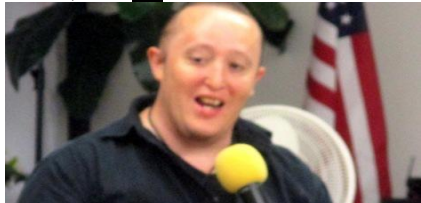
Pastor Patricia Smith of Christ-centered International Outreach Ministry

“Eph 4:1-6, one body. Eph 4:23, be renewed. Some of you, your mind went back, but we need to put back on the new man in order to have the spirit of unity. You must be touched by God, become one with him, and then you can walk in the Holy Spirit of God. Don’t go back. Don’t turn into a pillar of salt. My walk will be louder than my talk. People should be able to see it without you opening your mouth. If you are walking in the spirit of unity, you are not gonna just act any old way. You are the temple of the Holy Ghost. Let God be God in your body and over your life. We prevent this because we are not walking in unity with God or with our sisters and brothers.

“God is calling us into the deep. You have been on the shore too long. Go out into the deep. You will face things, but walk in the unity of the Spirit. The same power that raised Jesus from the dead is in you. Resurrection comes every day for me.

“Be renewed in your spirit and walk with the Lord daily. Do not tolerate sin. No more telling lies to one another. Choose today to walk in the unity of the Spirit of the Living God. That’s authentic unity, not surface unity. If God is with us, we will not live in defeat, but as **one**.



Henry Kidd of Inner Fountain Church

“When the Cohen gadol (high priest) entered the holy of holies, he had a bell and as log as the bell kept ringing, the people there with him knew he was still alive, but if it stopped, that meant that he was dead. Those that listened for him were called witnesses. Acts 2:1-8, they were a unified body. The high priest said, ‘You are my witnesses.’ With the sound of the shofar, we must be unified if we will be lifted up in his glory. They were in unity. Therefore, before he comes back, we must be in unity. Miryam of Magadan (Mary Magdalene) carried the gospel when she saw Yeshua risen and he **sent** her to tell Peter and the boys that he was risen. If he sent a woman to carry **that** word, we cannot say that a woman should not carry **this** word (Bible). The only way we’ll be ready in that moment is to get ready (be in unity) now.

“Your walk should be louder than your talk. I can see a sermon better than I can hear it. Eph 4:1, read the entire thing because milk does not do a body good unless you digest it. Your vocation, you calling, your purpose – you would die for this. This is what you do. Years ago if you were a carpenter, that is what **and** who you were. ‘Carpenter’ became your last name. Walk (live) worthy of the vocation. If you feel unworthy, get feeling worthy. There is far more to being a fisherman than just throwing a line out. You must catch some fish at night. Some you must go into the deep to get them. Not every fish likes worms. We are fishing for souls so we need the kind of bait it takes to catch them.

“1 Cor 9:7, what soldier serves at his own expense? Soldiers are paid. I Cor 9:27, castaways are defective coins minted in error. They have to be recycled – made again. You must beat your body and put it into submission. You know your weaknesses. That’s why we come together, to give us strength. We are not walking defeated, saints. We are going forward in God.”



Rabbanit Kim Otero of Congregation Tzur Yisrael

“How can we be unified? Studying the word and sharing in our community? Not enough! Prov 27:17, ‘as iron sharpens iron, so one man sharpens another. In Jewish circles you are matched up with some one at your level. There is accountability. Look at I Pet 3:15-16. To become good at defense – apologia – you must practice defending. When we are introverted, we choose to be by ourselves. The is the devil’s way of keeping you from being what God wants you to be. Isolationism is unhealthy, just as in Judaism, a scholar who sits alone to study Torah becomes stupid. The blood of the lamb already is, but the word of our testimony is still coming. Diversity is what makes studying together fruitful. This is unity. I Cor 12:12, many members, one body... ..if one is honored, all are honored. Remember, God spoke through a donkey; he can speak through an annoying know-it-all too.

“Prove 14:1, ‘The wise woman builds her house, but with her own hands, the foolish one tears hers down.’ Together we can minimize wrong or deceptive doctrine and bad teaching must be brought out from what it is hiding behind. There is much we can learn from one another. He is wise who can learn from every man.”

“I’ve got **two words**: Good news! I want good news. Who wants good news? Who **has** good news? People in the congregation are speaking our, ‘Jew and Gentile, one in Messiah.’ I want to tell you another piece of good news – The battlefield News. It goes all over the world. “What a night! Thank Rick for getting us all here. Is 12:3, the well of salvation, John 17, the longest prayer by Messiah. It was about unity. No one can snatch us out of the father’s hand. We must be one as he and the Father are one. Then we will naturally show love for one another and the world will see that we belong to Messiah. We persevere to ascend as Messiah so that we can be unified in the body, so that he will pour out his Spirit on all flesh and **all** will bow the knee before him, confessing that he is Lord and no other.

“It’s hard to follow up with such a movement in this place. Some of you were here with us at the seder.” The Rabbi said this as he took out some matzah. “This is matzah, unleavened bread. What is the difference? It is made of flour and water. In the exodus they did not have time to bake bread, so they carried on their shoulders. Today is the last of the seven days of matzah. It parallels Succoth. It also called the bread of affliction. Leaven has been associated with the sin of pride. In Num 16:3, Korah and his buddies came against Moses and Aaron, telling them that they just chose those offices themselves because everyone was holy. Moses and Aaron dropped to their knees, on their faces and prayed. It was their hearts that made the people understand. We can get puffed up and the enemy will try to stir us up. He will get his, but for now, it is his job to stir us up. The matzah represents the body of Messiah – humility.

God says it's not about you; it's about him. It will always be about him.

“I John 3:16, it’s like when Bishop Walker’s house burned down. It makes it so much easier when your brothers and sisters are there. V₁₇, how can the love of God be in him? No one ever told me they loved me until I came to Georgia. I see ministries where there is no joy> Let all our churches, all our ministries have joy. I am telling you the truth. I am giving you love.”

“I was raised in Ohio and began drinking when I was 11. By the time I was 23, I admitted to being an alcoholic. I moved to Georgia with my brother and thought drinking every day was normal. We were driving home one night and I was drunk. About ¼ mile from home we hit a car head-on. I did not have a driver’s license or insurance, but the laws were more lax then. My brother told me to run, but my ankle was broken and I could not. I was in the hospital and I heard two police officers talking. I heard one say that there were two fatalities and my heart sunk. I spent five years in the penitentiary, but I got saved. I thank God because, without that, I would not have turned to God.

“I want you all to know Jesus. I followed sin with all my heart; it was easy, but while people were doing all that nonsense in prison, I was on my bunk reading the Bible. I was asking, seeking and knocking for him to give me the Holy Spirit. Later is was driving down the road asking God to give me the Holy Spirit and a transformer exploded. He said ‘Receive the Holy Spirit by faith.’ That’s all you have to do. You either believe him or you don’t. Are you going to Hell or Heaven, smoking or nonsmoking. It’s that simple. He told me that if I chose to go back to alcohol again, it was my choice. If you are sold out to God, you have no desire for such things. Rom 1:16 should be the life scripture for all of us. And Verse 17 – the just shall live by faith.”

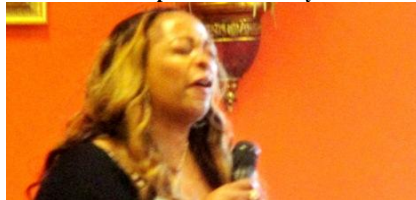

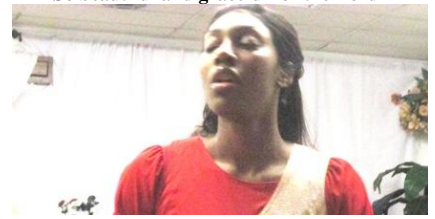

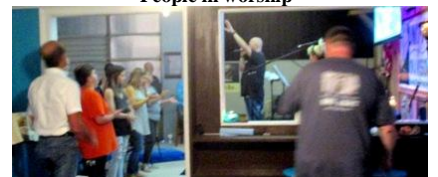

“Today we are being challenged on every front. God has not scraped the bottom of the barrel. You are supposed to be here. You were chosen.

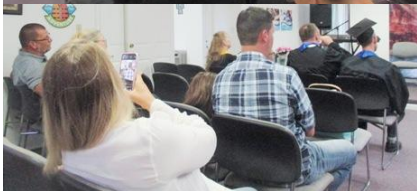

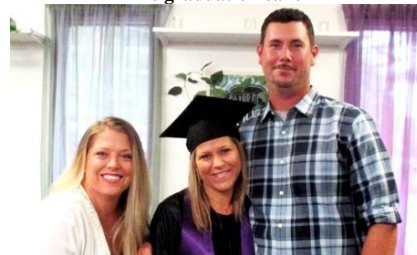

On Abortion

While many people consider the topic of abortion to be forbidden, I've never been afraid to publicly and unapologetically go there. So let's ride this train.

One common argument from abortion proponents is that any law that prevents or limits abortion somehow violates a so-called "separation of church and state". Rest assured that those who would argue this point are ignorant about the proper roles of both church and government in our nation. "We the People" agreed together from the founding of this nation on some very basic common moralities, especially that human life is sacred and must be protected. And "We the People" did that without Congress having to mandate that you join the Baptist Church or the Catholic Church, or mandating your participation in any national religion.

Protecting human life is part and parcel to our nation's founding documents. You know, that part about being endowed with certain unalienable rights including "life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness"? The rights to liberty and the pursuit of happiness necessarily come after the right to "life." Now, if a new mother were to shoot her one week old baby in the head and kill it, most sane people would argue that our government must now get involved in "her business," as she purposely took away an innocent, human life. In our nation, we call that murder. So is there any moral obligation for the same government body to protect and defend the life of that child **before** birth?

The primary role of legitimate government authority is to provide justice for the innocent against perpetrators of harm. The question then becomes, at what point does a government step in to defend the life of a child? Only after birth? How about 38 weeks gestation? How about 20 weeks? Remember, we are talking about **humans** here. At what point is the life of that child in the womb worth protecting by society? Does the fact that the child has yet to pass through the birth canal make him or her any less human? When should the "right to life" be conferred?

Will we put faith aside, for the moment, the fact that we have medical history which documents that very prematurely-born babies (21 weeks) have survived outside the womb and grown up to live full, normal lives? Medical technology has certainly increased premature survivability odds, and will likely continue to lower the premature survival age with future biomedical advances. Babies have even survived abortion attempts and gone on to live long and happy lives. But at present, it is still "legal" in our nation to abort a child well past known present-day gestational points of survival.

And any argument built around "it's my body and my choice" completely ignores the clear science of genetics. The child in the womb is a genetically unique and a distinctly separate human being that never previously existed. In abortion, there is always more than one human involved, and at least one out of two of the humans in this "medical procedure" will lose their life. How many people would choose a healthcare provider who had a 50-percent mortality rate in his or her practice? From a basic human rights standpoint, the argument that government has to "stay out of my business" or that the government is violating a so-called "separation of church and state" by limiting abortion simply doesn't hold water. Morally, human life is to be protected by society at large, and even as it may apply to a mother who seeks to end the life of her own child in the womb. The most basic right to life is considered "unalienable;" that is, it is a basic right conferred to all that cannot be taken away or denied, under any circumstance (regardless of the fact that in the 1973 Roe vs Wade decision by the Supreme Court stated that, since an unborn child has not yet entered our society, he or she has no constitutional rights).

Just because a child in the womb can't speak for itself doesn't mean that it's any less human, just as the one week old who can't speak for him or herself is any less human. And justice must speak up for those who have no voice. From the standpoint of "faith" it takes a spiritually blind person to not see this simple truth; abortion kills children, actual human beings. While the mother may be contracting the job out to the abortion provider, which seems more safe and palatable (to her), it's still no less than the execution of the innocent. Now, I'm not saying that women who have had abortions knew that what they were doing was akin to murder. Indeed, the entire abortion industry is built upon a foundation of lies and ignorance. Abortion providers know the truth, but they purposely keep women ignorant of the truth that abortion kills living human babies in order to keep the money flowing. While they say they are supporting a "woman's right to choose", fully 50-percent of their victims are unborn **women** in the womb, and they give those **women** no voice to choose life (not to mention the men whose voices are also silenced). These are evil, heartless contract killers who count on the ignorance of women in desperate circumstances in order to keep themselves in business.

The good news is that many mothers-to-be have made a choice against abortion after receiving appropriate medical and psychological counseling on the subject, and especially after using advanced

imaging technologies that allow the mother to see just how **human** the child in her womb really is. Seeing really is believing, and the abortion industry hates it! When most women learn the truth about abortion, they run in the other direction. And it takes our heavenly Father to heal the hearts of women who have had this evil perpetrated against them. There are no winners in the abortion business.

We can probably all agree that improving societal safety nets for at-risk or unwed mothers is certainly a good thing. However, the absence of those safety nets still doesn't justify the taking of a human life in the womb. We all know that there are hard cases out there, and we can talk about those. But let's all agree that abortion-on-demand as a form of birth control should be considered barbaric and taboo for any moral culture. Let's start there first.

Men and women of conscience, no matter what their faith or absence of faith, should be able to stand together for the basic right to human life, and to speak out for the most innocent and defenseless who have no voice for themselves.

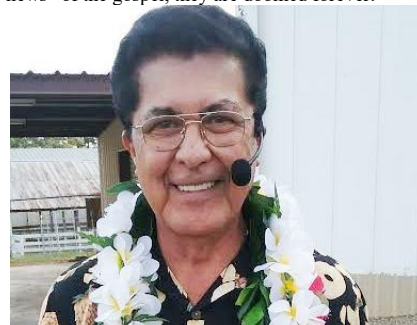
"Follow me and I will make you fishers of men."

Keeping Your Distance from Jesus

The night before Jesus was crucified, he took the time to tell Peter and the other disciples what to expect—that he would die, would be raised from the grave, and would meet them

later in Galilee (see Matthew 26:31–32). He was arrested that same night by armed men (Jewish Temple Guards, not Roman soldiers as most movies portray) and taken contemptuously before the high priest.

The other disciples scattered, but Peter followed behind Jesus—at a distance. When they got to the high priest's courtyard, Peter settled down a little ways away and waited to “see the end.” But Jesus had already told Peter and the others what was going to happen and what the end would be.

The Bible says, “*Peter followed Him at a distance to the high priest's courtyard. And he went in and sat with the servants to see the end*” (Matthew 26:58, NKJV).

Many Christians in America today want to follow Jesus at a distance. They want to give themselves a little room; they want to watch which way the wind will blow and see what the end will be.

When Jesus is portrayed in a good light or when it's comfortable, they will stand up there next to him. But if Jesus is going to be mocked or cursed or insulted, they want to stay back until they know how things will go.

But we already know what the end will be. You and I have the word of God, and we know there will be wars and famines and earthquakes. We know that one day the Lord Jesus Christ will come back to get his church and that we will be with him in Heaven for eternity because we have put our faith, our trust in him. We know what happens in the end to the devil and his demons, and we know what the end is for every person who rejects God's offer of salvation through Jesus Christ. So why would we want to follow Jesus at a distance? As we enter the New Year, it is a good time for each of us to examine the ways in which we may be trying to maintain a little space between us and our Lord. In whatever area of life it may be, don't keep your distance.

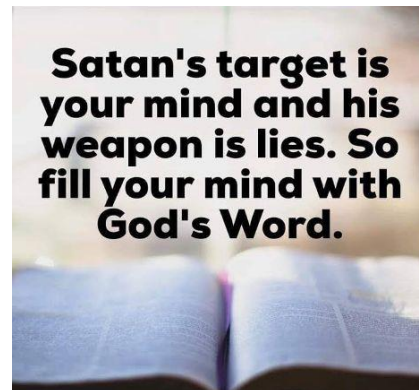
