P10-c What will Israel and the UN do About Jerusalem?

The Bible prophesies that a temporary peace agreement will be concluded between Israelis and the Palestinians, and that it will be supported by the UN. The agreement will create a Palestinian state in Judea-Samaria (the West Bank), the Temple Mount will be placed under a sharing arrangement so that Muslims and Jews can both worship there, and Israel will be allowed to build her Third Temple on the Temple Mount. This agreement will be a temporary or interim agreement because one issue will be left unresolved. Israel will refuse to re-divide or share Jerusalem, and the Palestinians will not sign a final agreement without their capital in Jerusalem. The issue of Jerusalem will be put on hold while implementing the rest of the agreement. It appears that the time frame for revisiting the Jerusalem issue will be seven years.

When the seven years expires, the Palestinians will press the issue of a capital in Jerusalem. The UN will side with the Palestinians and demand that Israel bow to the Palestinian demands. Israel will refuse, resulting in the military invasion of Israel by World Community forces.

Zechariah 14:2 clearly describes this invasion:

"For I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle; and the city shall be taken, and the houses rifled, and the women ravished; and half of the city shall go forth into captivity, and the residue of the people shall not be cut off from the city."

All nations coming against Jerusalem can only be fulfilled by the United Nations. The UN is the only force on earth that represents all the nations of the world. Notice in this verse that half of Jerusalem will fall to the world government forces, indicating that all of Jerusalem was under Israeli control through the entirety of the Final 7 Years.

What will motivate the United Nations to come against Jerusalem to battle? It will be Resolution 2334, by which the United Nations declared Israel's control of Jerusalem against international law. The UN will feel compelled to enforce its resolution or be viewed as a powerless paper tiger.

Yes. The world took its first step to the Battle of Armageddon on December 23, 2016!
